### OUR 2025 ESG GOALS

In compliance with our <u>Environmental, Social and Governance Policies</u>, we pledge to do the following:

#### **ENVIRONMENTAL**

1

By January 31, 2025, we will engage a qualified energy consultant to conduct a comprehensive energy assessment to identify at least three (3) specific opportunities for improving energy efficiency and achieving cost savings.

**SOCIAL**

By the end of 2025, we will engage with at least two (2) local organizations that support diverse talent to explore partnerships or collaboration opportunities.

Progress will be evaluated through a quarterly reflection on the partnerships and insights gained.

By the end of Q3, we will achieve a 90% reduction in paper and ink use by transitioning all client communications and internal documents to digital formats, and implementing cloud-based tools for documentation and project management.

We will track monthly reductions in paper and ink usage to assess progress and make adjustments as necessary.

By the end of Q2 2025, we will identify and engage with at least two (2) local minority- and woman-owned suppliers to incorporate their services into our supply chain.

We will document our progress in a quarterly report to evaluate the effectiveness of our supplier diversity efforts.

By the end of 2025, we will actively participate in supporting at least two local charitable organizations through donations and 10 hours of volunteer work, and sponsor one local event that aligns with our company values.

We will track and assess the impact of these activities through personal reflections and feedback from community members to evaluate community engagement efforts.

#### **GOVERNANCE**

By the end of 2025, we will establish a confidential feedback mechanism for customers and partners to report any human rights concerns related to business operations. We will promote this mechanism through our website and social media channels, aiming to receive at least two pieces of feedback or inquiries regarding human rights practices.

We will conduct a bi-annual review to evaluate the feedback and implement necessary improvements.
